### **General instructions:**

1. As of 10<sup>th</sup> of May 2021, **administrative & academic staff members** before entering the EUC premises **should have available:**
  - A. A negative rapid test for COVID-19 performed within the last 7 days before the day of their visit (all individuals **on their 1<sup>st</sup> day of attendance should have available a negative test, effective for 72 hours**), **or**
  - B. A Vaccination Certificate\* approved either by the Republic of Cyprus or Israel or UK, in combination with the requirement that **21 days must elapse since the administration of the 1<sup>st</sup> dose of the vaccine**, **or**
  - C. An official document by their personal doctor or an SMS by the Ministry of Health showing that they have contracted the coronavirus **in the past six months**.

**Students and visitors\*\* should provide** at least one of the evidence above at the defined entrance points before entering the premises.

2. Each student or staff member or visitor who is not holder of a Vaccination Certificate should be performing a rapid test by going at any of the testing units which are providing free tests to all, in accordance with the announcement on the website of Press and Information office ([www.pio.gov.cy](http://www.pio.gov.cy)).
3. For those who have difficulties to perform a rapid test during weekend as per the instruction above, EUC will be providing them an additional option to do the required test. A mobile testing unit will be at the outdoor area of the cafeteria every **Monday (07:30 a.m. – 09:30 a.m.)** and the tests will be supplied by the University.
4. Everyone should demonstrate personal responsibility in following the above guidelines for supporting the efforts of the organization to ensure a safe working and teaching environment for all.

### **Notes:**

\* *The vaccination certificate will be considered valid provided the vaccination has been carried out with one of the vaccines approved by the European Medicines Agency (EMA) and the required doses of the respective vaccine have been completed.*

\*\* *Visitors may include vendors, external collaborators for labs equipment, journalists etc.*
